Goderich Co-op Gallery Exposure 2024 Entry Instructions

- Bring the entry form, and all your entries to the gallery between the dates mentioned above and during the hours of operation. Be sure to bring them in all at the one time; not some one day, and others on other days.
- Each entrant is limited to five entries, but the gallery reserves the right to further limit entries at its sole discretion. We try to give equal space to all entrants. If we have more entries than we can accommodate, or if your art pieces are particularly large, we reserve the right to limit of pieces we display. The entry fee is \$20.00 for your first piece, and \$5.00 for each subsequent piece. There is no further commission or fee. Fees for unhung work will be refunded. Pieces for sale, and sold during the show will remain hanging until the end of the show. If the buyer lives too far away to return, we will allow the buyer to remove the piece, collect the amount and pass the sale amount to you,(as other sales are handled).
- This show is for original art, designed and created by you. Please do not submit copies of images or items you have seen in magazines etc.. or that you have designed and had someone else implement the design.
- If you have entered a series of items, and they are for sale individually, then each item is a separate entry. If they are for sale as group, then the group will be considered as one entry, provided the individual items are small. What counts as small will be up to the gallery member accepting your entries. If they are not for sale, acceptance as a group or individually will depend on their size, and still be at the gallery's discretion.
- Drop off and pick up dates are clearly noted. Please be sure you arrange to pick up your work or have someone pick it up for you on those dates. We will not store or be responsible for work not picked up.
- Please ensure that any hanging entries are properly mounted and/or framed. We won't do that for you. Refer to the "wiring page" in this information package.
- Labels will be made for you entries. We will not change your grammar or spelling, because artists sometimes like to deliberately use alternate spelling etc. for artistic effect. You are responsible for what appears on labelling.
- Elizabeth is offering a 25% discount on framing and mounting of all Exposure artwork. If you wish to take advantage of this offer, bring your work to the gallery and we will provide you with a discount certificate to take upstairs to get the work done. Please allow a minimum of two weeks for framing.
